



MANDATORY DECLARATION OF HTS CODE

The HS CODE (Harmonized System) or Customs Tariff is a classification system and specifies a product with a 6-digit code for tax reporting. Announced by The World Customs Organization (WCO) was formed by the cooperation of members of more than 176 countries and Thailand joined on 4 February 1972 and the system was accepted by the World Trade Organization. Organization: WTO) has therefore been adopted as an international trade.

- **THAILAND CUSTOMS: HTS code**

Please kindly note that Thailand Customs now required 6 digits of HTS Code.

- **JAPAN CUSTOMS: HTS code**

Please kindly note that Japan Customs required 6 digits of HTS Code.

Please kindly note that Malaysia Customs required 6 digits of HTS Code.
